

Diary Notes

1. Sunday 4th November will be the last Sunday service at which our vicar Robert will preside. This will be a celebration of Robert and Emma's 22 years in the Benefice and the service will include many faces old and new. Following there will be a Farewell Lunch in Hallow Parish Hall. This will be a finger buffet and a cash bar will be available. There will be no charge for the lunch but if you would like to make a donation on the day that would be most welcome. 2. The only significant variation to our November services is that it is Remembrance Sunday on 11th November. This is a special celebration of 100 years since the World War I Armistice. There will be an 8:30am Communion Service in Grimley and then the main service will be at Hallow at 10:30am. This is a Benefice Service which will include an Act of Remembrance and the Roll of Honour from all three churches will be read out. Both Schools in the Benefice will be represented as well as the uniformed organisations. In the afternoon there will be an Armistice Event at the Sinton green Peace Hall. Then in the evening we shall be joining with the national commemoration by lighting a Beacon on Holt Memorial Green.
